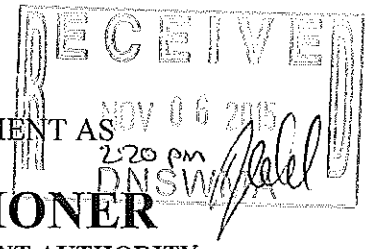

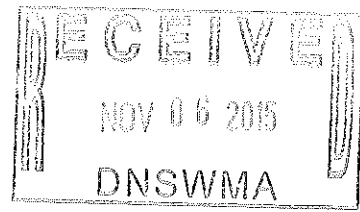


I am writing this to provide additional information for my application as the public commissioner for the Del Norte Solid Waste Authority Board of Commissioners.

I seek this position for a number of reasons:

1. After taking two college-classes dealing with the natural environment, (Sociology 13: Culture, Society, and Environment and Environmental Science 10), I have developed a new sense of responsibility for preserving our natural environment. My background as a community organizer and a youth leader in our community motivates me to bring Del Norte County towards a more ecologically sound future. The Solid Waste Management Authority is tasked with two objectives: providing services and reducing environmental "bads." My aim is to focus more on the latter than the former.
2. As the public commissioner, my job ought to consist of more than voting at meetings. The public commissioner needs to have a direct relationship with the community he or she serves. Therefore, I would hope to engage with the public through a number of venues alternative to the regularly scheduled DNSWMA meetings. I would host forums, meet with the Solid Waste Task Force, and work with Director Ward on outreach to schools. The community needs to understand the environmental impact of solid waste. It is incumbent upon the Authority to forge that understanding.
3. Lastly, I wish to restore the public's trust in the Solid Waste Management Authority. It seems like the DNSWMA taints all who associate with it, from the Director to the commissioners. I too cannot indict the Authority or its Commission without admitting that even I was called by the Grand Jury. My testimony proves that no one is above inquiries or allegations. The glaringly negative public perception of the Authority prevents the Authority from doing its job properly. The controversy surrounding the Authority is not any one person's fault, but changing the narrative is every commissioner's duty. As a person who desires to serve his community, I wish to restore the public's trust in the DNSWMA, thus restoring the notion that government is here to do good for all people. As a young person, I am more equipped than any other applicant to perform this obligation, for my age provides me the benefit of having no political baggage.

In conclusion, I am more than willing to put the time in that's needed to do the job well. I look forward to serving the public and building a better future, together. Thank you for considering my appointment as public commissioner to the Del Norte Solid Waste Management Authority.

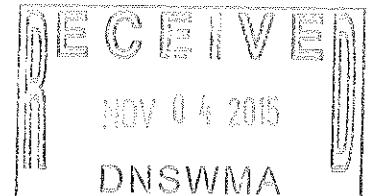

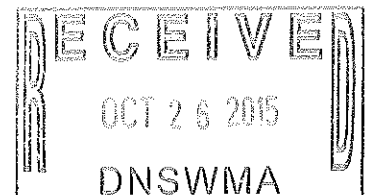

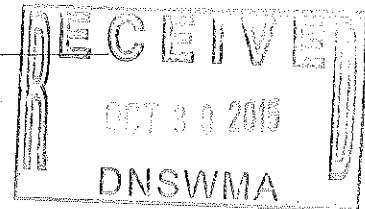
